White wines

Akres - Skouras estate | 12.5% vol - 25€

Roditis, Moschofilero

Dry Bright white – yellow with green hues. The aroma is flooded with fresh fruit such as citrus, apricot and touches of jasmine and mint. The taste is relatively light, fresh and very pleasant and the aftertaste is fruity.

Thalasoinos - Strataridaki Winery | 13% vol - 30€

Chardonnay 100%

Golden-yellow and shiny in appearance, rich and refreshing with a dense nose of citrus blossom and sweet lemon. A typical representative of the cosmopolitan variety in its Mediterranean version, with crisp acidity, almost crunchy, it will reveal in its impressive aftertaste an unforgettable sea breeze. Pairs well with seafood and fish.

Ktima Alfa White | 13% vol - 55€

Sauvignon Blanc

Crystal-clear and shiny with a sub-yellow color, with greenish reflections. The nose is intense and rich, typical of the variety, with aromas of citrus, passion fruit, lychee, and with a sweet melon undertone. In the mouth, it is quite full, sweet, oily, with excellent balance, freshness, and finesse. Lively aftertaste contributing to the long persistence of aromas.

Douloufakis Dafnios White | 13.5% vol - 30€

Vidiano

Yellow bordering on gold, while the nose is fully developed aromatically, with a ripe fruity character reminiscent of lemon marmalade, bergamot, and tropical hints of mango. In the background, several herbal nuances emerge, reminiscent of chamomile, tea, and perhaps some jasmine flowers and vegetation. Dry on the palate, with acidity perfectly balancing the oiliness and thickness of the wine, and the aftertaste impresses with its duration and the rich sensation it leaves in the mouth.

Ktima Mpougiouri Malagouzia | 12% vol - 25€

Malagouzia

A different perspective of Malagousia. On the nose, chamomile, peach, jasmine, and herbal notes prevail, characteristic of the variety. Cool mouthfeel, nice acidity, elegant and fruity aftertaste. It pairs well with Asian cuisine dishes, salads.

Moschato D' Asti | 5% vol - 35€

Moscato Bianco

Italy Sweet aromas of peaches, fresh grapes, orange blossom and crisp Meyer lemons. The taste stings your tongue from the acidity and fizz from the carbon dioxide. The semi-sparkling style (in Italian: frizzante) gives the impression that Moscato d'Asti is slightly sweet.

Rose wines

Akakies - Kir Yianni Winery | 13% vol - 30€

Xinomavro 100%

Bright, with a rich aromatic character aromas of strawberry and small red forest fruits compose the typically seductive character of the wine. The round acidity is refreshing, without the pungent intensity of an Amyndeon rosé, while the wine finishes with a lingering, fruity aftertaste. Fruity with vegetal notes, refreshing acidity and a lingering aftertaste.

Paraga rose - Kyr Giannis | 12% vol - 25€

Xinomavro, Syrah

Salmon color reveals a wine with finesse and a pleasing character. On the nose, vivid aromas of peach and fine notes of white flowers. Refreshing acidity balances with the subtle sweetness, which contributes to a wine with a rich mouth feel and a lingering aromatic finish.

Pixie Markou Rose | 12% vol - 30€

Agiorgitiko, Mochato

The Markou family is known for its exceptional wines from the Mediterranean region. Pixie of Markou Vineyards is a highly fruity, refreshing, and tasty wine made from the Agiorgitiko and Moschofilero varieties. It has a rosy, almost confetti-like color in the glass. The nose is summery and light, with aromas of cherry, strawberry, and blackberry combined with notes of Turkish delight and acacia. Light and medium-bodied on the palate, with a semi-dry sensation and moderate acidity.

Red wines

Fortant de France | 13% vol - 35€

Cabernet Sauvignon

Deep red color with violet reflections. Intense, complex aroma of red fruits, leather, and smoke. Spicy, robust wine with a long aftertaste.

Ktima Semeli Oreinos Helios | 13% vol - 30€

Syrah, Agiorgitiko

Young, deep ruby color, with purple reflections and dense tears. Intense nose, with ripe fruit, chocolate, subtle vanilla, and a few spicy notes indicating a brief passage through the barrel. Full-bodied on the palate, with velvety tannins and ideal acidity. Very intense flavors of red fruits in the mouth, especially on the finish. It can age for 2 to 4 years from the harvest, and it pairs well with pasta dishes with red sauces, grilled meats, and a variety of hard cheeses and cured meats.

Vivlia Hora | 13.5% vol - 50€

Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot

Wine with a deep purple color that matures for about 12 months in new French oak barrels. Complex and clean aroma of ripe red fruits, caramel, cedar, chocolate with some spicy notes on the finish. Plentiful and intense flavor with a rich body, good structure, and strong presence of tannins that give it a long aftertaste and great aging potential.

Petali Diamantakis | 13% vol - 30€

Liatiko

Red dry wine with aromas of red and black fruits such as strawberry, apricot, blackberry, fig, combined with notes of spices like cinnamon, cloves. Served at 14°C, it pairs well with cold cuts, red sauces, mild cheeses, tuna fillet, and beef tenderloin.

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
